


2. Field Visit to Pazhassi Smriti Mandiram, Mattannur

Department of History organized short field trip/visit for III DC History students on June 22, 2022 to the nearby Pazhassi Smriti Mandiram in Mattannur preserved by the Mattannur Nagarasabha. Dr. Sr. Manju O.S., Head and Assistant Professor, Department of History, Sr. Sujamol Joseph, Assistant Professor, Department of History and Ms. Reshma Tom, Assistant Professor, Department of History accompanied the students. 34 students were a part of the visit.

Pazhassi Raja Smrithi Mandiram, located at Pazhassi, Mattannur in Kannur, is a museum dedicated to Pazhassi Raja at his ancestral place. This is constructed in the model of a Kuthambalam. This museum is built above a pond, which was once a part of the palace complex of Pazhassi Raja. After Pazhassi's death in 1805, the British demolished the entire palace complex and built the Thalassery-Mysore Highway. The outer side of the museum wall has beautiful mural paintings depicting the life of Pazhassi Raja. Several letters and documents of communication with the British are displayed inside the museum. A single stone statue of Pazhassi Raja is another notable attraction in the museum. Many paintings which illustrate the life events of Pazhassiraja are seen on the walls of building.








3. Reading Day Celebration








9. Charity Visit









11. Legal Awareness Programme

It changed hands between the Dutch and eventually the British, who remodeled and reequipped it into their primary military stronghold in Malabar. People get a brilliant view of Arabian Sea from the fort. The fort has army barracks and huge cannons kept in various sides. The fort is well preserved and maintained by the Archaeological survey of India now.

The visit helped the students to understand the historical significance of monuments like forts. It also gave them an insight into the significance of preservation of historical monuments.








14. Grand Alumni Meet and History Alumni Group 'Nellikka'






15. National Youth Day Training Programme









16. National Seminar on 'Samkshepavedartham and Modern Discourses'




21. PSTA Meeting








23. Farwell to III DC History Students (2020-2023 batch)
