Department of History organized one day Field trip for II DC History students on Sunday March 13, 2022. Two teachers and 24 students participated. Places visited-

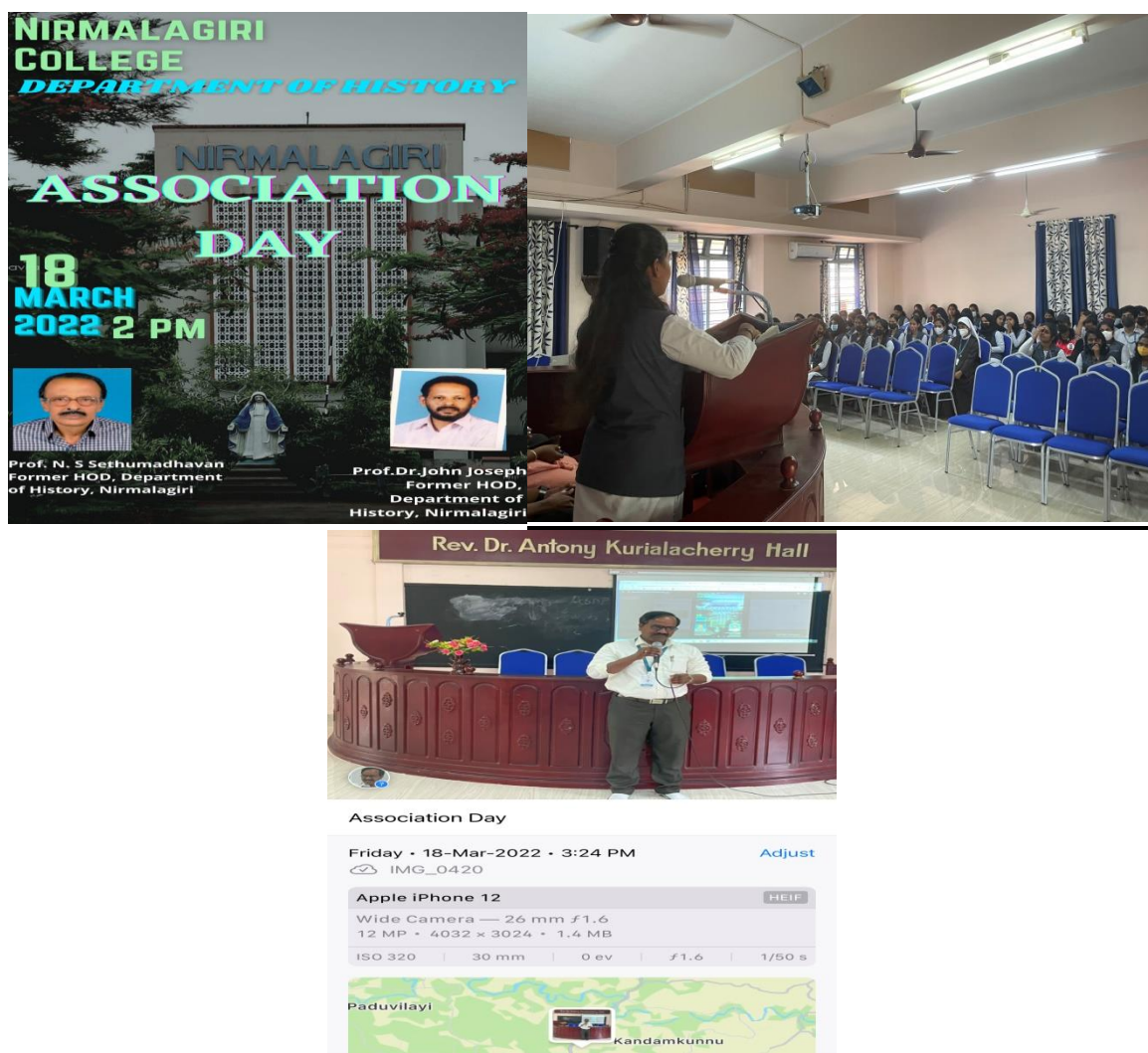
