REPORT

The International Conference on Advanced Materials (ICAM 2019) was organized successfully at Nirmalagiri College, Kannur, Kerala, India from 12th to 14th June 2019. Prof. P. Knoll, Institute of Experimental Physics, University of Graz, Vienna, Austria inaugurated the event which was chaired by Mar. Joseph Pamplani, Auxiliary Bishop of Thalasserry Arch Diocese and the Manager of the College.

The Conference drew huge response and participation from scientists, engineers, researchers, students and leaders in the fields of Materials Science and Nanotechnology, who made this event successful. It also provided invaluable networking opportunities, deploying the foundation for new research endeavors and development of scientific projects.



The Conference website has registered 35000 plus visitors from across the globe. 1300 plus registrations were received out of which 400 were invited to present their papers after scrutiny of the abstracts submitted. The conference was attended by 350 plus delegates from India and abroad and more than 300 papers were presented on the days in Oral and Poster modes. A total of 27 distinguished speakers interacted with the delegates through Plenary and Invited talks. The event was covered extensively by print and visual media.

The meeting was carried out through various sessions, in which discussions were held on major scientific tracks such as Advanced materials, Nanomaterials, Composite materials, superconducting materials, metamaterials, photonic, spintronic and energy harvesting materials, grapheme etc.



The Conference Sessions included Plenary Talks, Invited Talks, Oral and Poster presentations.
